The *Puget Sound Council of Teachers of Mathematics* was founded to encourage continual professional growth among local mathematics teachers. The organization sponsors four major activities during the year: a fall, a winter, and a spring dinner and a summer picnic. A variety of programs are presented at these events ranging from using a given manipulative in grades K-12 to the role teachers are playing in the new assessments. The focus of the meetings is to link mathematical best practices, and the State GLE's to classroom teaching. Emphasis is placed on promoting cross-grade level and grade-level specific discussions by using a K-16 general topic. Handouts and take-home activities are often provided.
